Oh My!! This Knit Hat Scarf is so comfortable!! So soft!! You will want to highly

consider making this one for yourself. Great for keeping yourself warm during the winter. It fits adult head and made with thick yarn. Made from two pieces you then sew together.

Materials: Lion Brand yarn: 3 Skeins of Hometown USA- Super Bulky: Los Angeles Tan, Size 9 MM Knitting Needles, Cable Needle, and Darning Needle.

K=Knit

P=Purl

Inc= Increase By Working in front and back loops.

Dec = Purl 2 together

CN=Cable Needle

Sts= Stitches

C6F= Cable 6 in front, place 3 sts on cable needle and hold in front of work, K3,Then K3 off of Cable needle.

C8F= Cable 8 front, place 4 sts on cable needle and hold in front of work, K4, Then K4 off of Cable needle.

## Hat

Cast on 36

Row 1: K6, P8, K8, P8, K6.

Row 2: P6, K8, P8, K8, P6.

Row 3: C6f, Inc, P6, Inc, C8f, Inc, P6, Inc, C6f.

Row 4: P6, K10, P8, K10, P6.

Row 5: K6, Inc, P8, Inc, K8, Inc, P8, Inc, K6.

Row 6: P6, K12, P8, K12, P6

Row 7: C6F, Inc, P9, Inc, 1 st on CN behind, K4, P1 off CN, 4 STS on CN in front of work, P1, K4 off CN, Inc, P9, Inc, C6F.

Row 8: P6, K13, P4, K2, P4, K13, P6.

Row 9: K6, Inc, P10, Inc, 1 st on CN and hold in back, K4, P1 off CN, P2, 4 sts on CN and hold in front, P1, K4 off CN, Inc, P10, Inc, K6.

Row 10: P6, K14, P4, K4, P4, K14, P6.

Row 11: C6F, Inc, P11, Inc, 1 st on CN hold behind, K4, P1 from CN, P4, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, Inc, P11, Inc, C6F.

Row 12: P6, K15, P4, K6, P4, K15, P6.

Row 13: K6, Inc, P14, K4, P6, K4, P14, Inc, K6.

Row 14: P6, K16, P4, K6, P4, K16, P6.

Row 15: C6F, Inc, P15, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, P4, 1 st onto CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P15, Inc, C6F.

Row 16: P6, K18, P4, K4, P4, K18, P6.

Row 17: K6, Inc, P17, 4 sts on CN and hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, P2, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P17, Inc, P6.

Row 18: P6, K19, P5, K2, P5, K19, P6.

Row 19: C6F, P20, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P20, C6F.

Row 20: P6, K21, P8, K21, P6.

Row 21: K6, P21, Cable 8, P21, K6.

Row 22: P6, K21, P8, K21, P6.

Row 23: C6F, P21, K8, P21, C6F.

Row 24: P6, K21, K8, K21, P6.

Row 25: K6, P20, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, P20, K6.

Row 26: P6, K20, P4, K2, P4, K20, P6.

Row 27: C6F, P19, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P2, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, P19, C6F.

Row 28: P6, K19, P5, K4, P5, K19, P6.

Row 29: K6, P18, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, P2, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P18, K6.

Row 30: P6, K20, P4, K2, P4, K20, P6

Row 31: C6F, P20, 4 sts on CN hold in front, P1, K4 from CN, 1 st on CN hold in back, K4, P1 from CN, P20, C6F.

Row 32: P6, K21, P8, K21, P6.

Row 33: K6, P21, Cable 8, P21, K6.

Row 34: P6, K21, P8, K21, P6, Tie off.

Slip 24 sts onto right needle un-worked and attach yarn and begin working up the middle of hat decreasing in sts as you go.

Working Up Middle Of Hat:

Row 35: P1, Dec, K8, Dec, P1, turn.

Row 36: K2, P8, K3, Turn.

Row 37: Rep 35.

Row 38: Rep 36.

Row 39: P1, Dec, C8F, Dec, P1, Turn.

Row 40: Rep row 36

Row 41: Rep Row 35

Row 42: Rep Row 36

Row 43: rep Row 35

Row 44: Rep Row 36

Rows 45-68: Reo Rows 39-44. (4 repeats)

Row 69: Rep Row 39

Row 70: Rep Row 36

Row 71: Rep Row 35

Row 72: Rep Row 36 except end with K2 instead of K3, turn.

Row 73: P2tog, (K2tog) 4times, P2tog, K6.

Row 74: Cast off first 6 sts, Cast of next 6 sts 2 at a time, Cast off Last 6 sts. Leave long tail for sewing.

Finishing Off the Hat

Fold Row 74 in half with right sides facing each other.

Sew row 74 together.

Then take the tip of the hat by the forehead and roll it slightly under and sew down it gives you a much better look that matches the rest of the hat.



## Scarf

Cast on 8 STS

Row 1: K1, P6, K1

Row 2: Inc, K6, Inc. (right Side)

Row 3: K2, P6, K2.

Row 4: P1, Inc, K6, Inc, P1.

Row 5: K3, P6, K3.

Row 6: P2, Inc, C6F, Inc, P2

Row 7: K4, P6, K4.

Row 8: P3, Inc, K6, Inc, P3.

Row 9: K5, P6, K5.

Row 10: P4, Inc, K6, Inc, P4.

Row 11: K6, P6, K6.

Row 12: P6, C6F, P6.

Row 13: K6, P6, K6.

Row 14: P6, K6, P6.

Row 15: Rep 13

Row 16: Rep 14

Row 17: Rep 13

Rep Rows 12-17 until scarf is about 44" long.

Row 18: P4, Dec, C6F, Dec, P4.

Row 19: K5, P6, K5.

Row 20: P3, Dec, K6, Dec, P3

Row 21: K4, P6, K4.

Row 22: P2, Dec, K6, Dec, P2.

Row 23: K3, P6, K3.

Row 24: P1, Dec, C6F, Dec, P1.

Row 25: K2, P6, K2.

Row 26: Dec, P6, Dec.

Row 27: K1, P6, K1.

Row 28: Cast off

Block you work.

Putting the Hat and Scarf together

Find the middle of the scarf and row 1 of hat and pin together.

Take a darning needle and sew the hat and scarf together.

Optional: Make pom poms and sew them to each of the ends of the scarf. I made four pom pom's and put two on each side.
